



ORIGINAL GARMENT: 82 - 87cm.

MATERIALS:

7(8,9) Balls **LOVE** 50g
Colour - 3075

7mm Knitting needle
8mm Knitting needle
7mm Circular knitting needle
7mm Knitting needles (extra)
3 Stitch holders
Place markers

TENSION:

13sts x 14rows = 10cm over stocking stitch using 7mm knitting needles.

MEASUREMENT:

To fit: 82-87,92-97,102-107cm
Actual: 104, 110, 124cm
Length to shoulder: 64cm
Sleeve seam: 47,48,46cm

ABBREVIATIONS:

alt - alternate, **beg** - begin(ning),
cont - continue, **dec** - decrease,
fol - follow(ing), **inc** - increase,
k - knit, **n(s)** - needle(s), **patf(s)** -
pattern(s), **p** - purl, **prev** - previous,
rem - remain(ing), **rep** - repeat,
rev - reverse, **R(L)H** - right (left) hand,
R(W)SF - right (wrong) side facing, **R(W)**
SR - right (wrong) side row, **sl** - slip, **st(s)** -
stitch(es), **tog** - together

NOTES:

SPECIAL HOLE:

SR = short row, before turning, bring yarn to opposite side of work, sl next st on LH n, return yarn to opposite side of work, return the sl st back on LH n.

3 NEEDLE CAST OFF:

With equal number of sts on 2 ns, hold ns tog, WSF, using a 3rd needle, cast off, working the sts on both ns tog.

STITCHES USED:

Stocking stitch (st st)

1st Row: (RSF), k.
2nd Row: P.

Rev stocking stitch (Rev st st)

1st Row: (RSF), P.
2nd Row: K.

PATTERN:

BACK:

Using 8mm ns, cast on 84 (90,96)sts, k row.
Note: Turn after each row.
1st Row: (RSF), k49(55,61)sts. (SR method)

2nd Row: P14(20,26)sts.

3rd Row: K19(25,31)sts.

4th Row: P24(30,36)sts.

5th Row: K29(35,41)sts.

6th Row: P34(40,46)sts.

7th Row: K39(45,51)sts.

8th Row: P44(50,56)sts.

9th Row: K49(55,61)sts.

10th Row: P54(60,66)sts.

11th Row: K59(65,71)sts.

12th Row: P64(70,76)sts.

13th Row: K69(75,81)sts.

14th Row: P74(80,86)sts.

15th Row: K.

16th Row: P.

Work 2 more rows in st st RSF dec st each end of next, then every 10th(8th,8th) row 5(7,6)times. (= 72(74,82)sts)

Cont straight until work measures 46(47,46)cm on short side end with WSR. Place markers each side, change to 7mm ns.

Next Row: (RSF), P. Cont working in rev st st until armhole measures 16(17,18)cm from place marker end with a WSR.

Next Row: P26(27,30)sts, cast off 20(20,22) sts, p to end. Place these sts on stitch holders.

FRONT:

Using 8mm ns, cast on 84 (90,96)sts, k row.

Note: Turn after each row.

1st Row: (RSF), k5.

2nd and alternate Rows: P.

3rd Row: K10.

5th Row: K2tog, k13.

7th Row: K19.

9th Row: K24.

Cont working 5sts more on RSR's at the same time dec st at side edge on 0(8th, 8th)row from prev dec until 34(33,33)sts on RH n.

Next Row: K.

RIGHT SIDE OF FRONT:

1st Row: (WSF), p5.

2nd and alt rows: (RSF), k.

3rd Row: P10sts.

4th Row: K to last 2sts, k2tog.

5th Row: P14sts.

7th Row: P19sts.

9th Row: P24sts.

Cont working 5sts more on WRS's at the same time dec st at side edge on 0(8th, 8th)row from prev dec until 34(33,33)sts on RH n, turn, k to end.

Next Row: P.

Cont working in st st and shaping sides as for back to armhole markers end with

WSR, place markers each side, change to 7mm ns.

Next Row: (RSF), p.

Next Row: K, cont working in rev st st.

Next Row: Shape Neck: (RSF), p34(35,39) sts, P2tog, leave rem 36(37,41)sts on a stitch holder for right front. Cont working sts for left front dec st at neck edge on foll alt rows until 26(27,30)sts rem.

Cont straight until work measures 16(17, 18)cm from marker, end with WSR.

Sl sts for left back shoulder onto a 7mm n. Holding these 2 ns tog, RSF, cast off using 3 n method. RSF, join yarn to sts for right front.

Next Row: P2tog, p to end.

Complete as for left front.

SLEEVES (BOTH ALIKE):

Using 7mm ns, cast on 32(32,34)sts. K one row. Change to 8mm ns, RSF, k, cont in st st, inc st each end of 5th then every 12th(10th,10th)row until 42(44,46)sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 47(48, 46)cm end with WSR, cast off.

NECK BAND:

Using 7mm circular n, RSF, pick up k25(27, 29)sts down left front neck, k25(27,29)sts up right side front neck.

K20(20,22)sts across back neck = 70(74, 80)sts.

Next round: P, cast off loosely.

FINISHING:

Fold sleeves in half lengthways. Place folds on shoulder seams, sew sleeve into position between markers. Sew side seams and sleeve seams.
