

DIAMOND SNOOD AND WRIST WARMERS

IMPORTANT NOTE: Unless yarn specified is used, African Expressions cannot accept the responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

Original garments worked in one size and shown on a size 87cm model.

Pattern and Design by Dorothy Jacobs.

MATERIALS:

ADORE (100g balls)

SNOOD: 3 balls 8297.

WRIST WARMERS: 2 balls.

SNOOD: One 7,5mm circular knitting needle, one cable needle and one stitch marker.

WRIST WARMERS: One set each of 4,5mm and 5mm knitting needles and one cable needle.

MEASUREMENTS:

SNOOD: Approx. circumference 78cm by 42cm length.

WRIST WARMERS: To fit average size hand, 27cm long.

THE INSTRUCTIONS ARE GIVEN FOR ONE SIZE ONLY.

TENSION: SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME, CHECK TENSION.

SNOOD: 14sts and 18 rows = 10cm over Stocking Stitch using a 7,5mm circular needle.

WRIST WARMERS: 18sts and 23 rows = 10cm over Stocking Stitch using 5mm needles.

FOR BEST RESULTS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT TENSION.

IF THERE ARE TOO FEW STS ON TEST SWATCH, USE THINNER NEEDLES;

IF THERE ARE TOO MANY STS, USE THICKER NEEDLES.

ABBREVIATIONS:

alt = alternate; **beg** = begin(ning); **cont** = continue; **dec** = decrease; **fol** = follow(ing); **inc(s)** = increase; **k** = knit; **patt(s)** = pattern(s); **p** = purl; **rem** = remain(ing); **rep** = repeat; **R(W)** = right(wrong) side facing; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **T3F** = slip next 2sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, p next st from left hand-needle, then k sts from cable needle; **T3B** = slip next st onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k next 2sts from left-hand needle, then p st from cable needle.

STITCHES USED (Work in rounds):

JOINED DIAMONDS (multiple of 10sts):

1st and 2nd rounds: *K2, p6, k2*, rep from * to end.

3rd round: *T3L, p4, T3R*, rep from * to end.

4th and alt rounds: Work sts, as they appear (K the Knit sts and P the Purl sts), except rounds 12 and 22nd.

5th round: *P1, T3L, p2, T3R, p1* rep from * to end.

7th round: *P2, T3L, T3R, p2*, rep from * to end.

9th and 11th rounds: P.

12th round: *P3, k4, p3*, rep from * to end.

13th round: *P2, TBR, T3L, p2*, rep from * to end.

15th round: *P1, T3R, p2, T3L, p1*, rep from * to end.

17th round: *T3R, p4, T3L*, rep from * to end.

19th to 21st rounds: P.

22nd round: *K2, p6, k2*, rep from * to end.

Rep from round 3 from following patterns.

SNOOD:

Using a 7,5mm circular needle, cast on 120sts. Working in rounds (Place marker at Beg). **Border Stitch: 1st round:** P. **2nd round:** K. Rep 1st and 2nd rounds once more, then 1st round again. Work in Joined Diamond Pattern (SEE STS USED) until snood measures 40cm from beg, ending with an 8th round of patt. Work 5 rows of border stitch as beg, cast off all sts.

WRIST WARMERS

RIGHT HAND:

Using 5mm needles, cast on 36sts. Place sts as follows: 1st needle 16sts, 2nd and 3rd needles 10sts each. Working in rounds. **Border Stitch: 1st round:** P. **2nd round:** K. Rep 1st and 2nd rounds once more, then 1st round again. **Next round:** 1st needle, k4, work Joined Diamond Patt over 10sts, k2, 2nd and 3rd needles knit. Cont in patt as now set until 2 patt repeat are complete*, now work 3rd to 11th round working thumb opening on 10th and 11th rounds as follows. Move 4sts from 3rd needle to end of 2nd needle. **10th round:** 1st needle k4, p10, k2, 2nd needle, k4, cast off 8sts, k to end of round. **11th round:** Cast on 6sts over cast off sts = 34sts. Change to 4,5mm needles. Work 5 rows of border st as before. Cast off all sts.

LEFT HAND:

Work as for Right Hand until *, move 4sts from 2nd needle to 3rd needle. **10th round:** 1st needle k4, p10, k2, 2nd needle knit 3rd needle k4, cast off 8sts, k to end. Complete as for Right Hand.
