

## TEXTURED INFINITY SCARF

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Unless yarn specified is used, African Expressions cannot accept the responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

Original garment worked in one size only and shown on a size 87cm model.

Pattern Designed and Knitted by Dorothy Jacobs.

**MATERIALS:** FREEDOM AND COMFORT (50g balls)  
SCARF: 4 balls 5081 (Freedom); 1 ball 4081 (Comfort).  
1 pair 6mm knitting needles.

2 stitch holders.

**BOBBLES:** One pair each 3mm and 3,75mm knitting needles.

One large safety pin.

One 3,5mm crochet hook.

Toy stuffing.

### MEASUREMENTS:

Length: 120cm

Width: 30cm

THE INSTRUCTIONS ARE GIVEN FOR ONE SIZE ONLY.

### TENSION: SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME, CHECK TENSION.

16sts and 28 rows = 10cm over Garter Stitch using 6mm needles.

FOR BEST RESULTS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT TENSION.

IF THERE ARE TOO FEW STS ON TEST SWATCH, USE THINNER NEEDLES;

IF THERE ARE TOO MANY STS, USE THICKER NEEDLES.

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**alt** = alternate; **beg** = begin(ning); **cont** = continue; **dec** = decrease; **fo**ll = follow(ing); **inc(s)** = increase; **k** = knit; **patt(s)** = pattern(s); **p** = purl; **rem** = remain(ing); **rep** = repeat; **rev** = reverse; **rev st st** = reverse stocking stitch; **R(W)SF** = right(wrong) side facing; **R(W)SR** = right(wrong) side row; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together.

### STITCHES USED:

**GARTER STITCH:**

Knit every row.

**TWISTED DROP STITCH:**

K, winding yarn round both needles once then round right hand needle in the normal way, on next row: K letting extra loop drop.

### REVERSE STOCKING STITCH:

**1st row:** RSF, one row P.

**2nd row:** WSF, one row K.

Rep these 2 rows.

### SCARF:

**Note:** After 2 rows of Comfort, carry Freedom up side edge without stretching, when working with Freedom, weave Comfort up side edge every right side row.

Using 6mm needles and Freedom, cast on 48sts. Work 12 rows in Garter Stitch. Join Comfort, \*work 2 rows of Twisted Drop Stitch, 14 rows of Garter Stitch using Freedom. Cont working from \* until work measures 120cm ending with 2nd row of Freedom. Cast off all sts.

### TO MAKE UP:

With right sides together, join cast on edge to cast off edge.

### BOBBLES IN FREEDOM (Make 2):

Using 3mm needles and Freedom, cast on 12sts. RSF, p. **Next row:** K, inc in each st = 24sts. Starting with a p row, work 12 rows in rev st st. **Next Row:** P2tog to end = 12sts. Thread yarn through rem sts, leave a 15cm thread. Gather cast on edge, draw up tightly, secure. Sew side edge together. Stuff firmly with toy stuffing. Draw cast of thread through sts tightly.

### BOBBLES IN COMFORT (Make 3):

Using 3,75mm needles and Comfort, cast on 12sts. Work as for Freedom working 10 rows of rev st st in place of 12 rows.

### TO MAKE UP:

Work blanket stitch over top bar of pin. Using a 3,5mm crochet hook, work chain stitch with matching yarn of bobbles, in various lengths. Attach to each bobble at end of chain. Attach the first bobble directly to the pin. **Tip:** The yarn being thick use matching cotton to attach bobbles to the pin bar. Attach the 1st bobble directly to pin bar.

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
