## LACE SCARF

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Unless yarn specified is used, African Expressions cannot accept the responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

Original garment worked in one size only.

**MATERIALS:** HOPE (25g balls)

2 balls 6103

One pair 4mm knitting needles.

### MEASUREMENTS:

17cm x 200cm.

*THE INSTRUCTIONS ARE GIVEN FOR THE ONE SIZE ONLY.*

### TENSION: SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME, CHECK TENSION.

26sts and 30 rows = 10cm over Lace pattern using 4mm needles.

*FOR BEST RESULTS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT TENSION.*

*IF THERE ARE TOO FEW STS ON TEST SWATCH, USE THINNER NEEDLES;*

*IF THERE ARE TOO MANY STS, USE THICKER NEEDLES.*

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**alt** = alternate; **beg** = begin(ning); **k** = knit; **patt(s)** = pattern(s); **p** = purl; **rep** = repeat; **R(W)SR** = right(wrong) side row; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **sl** = slip; **SKPO** = slip one, k one, pass slipped st over; **tog** = together; **yfd** = yarn forward.

### STITCHES USED:

LACE PATTERN (worked over a multiple of 11sts + 2sts):

**1st row:** RSF, k1, \*k2tog, k3, yfd, k1, yfd, k3, SKPO, rep from \* to last st, k1.

**2nd and every alt row:** P.

**3rd and 5th rows:** Work as 1st row.

**7th row:** K1, \*k2tog, k2, yfd, k3, yfd, k2, SKPO, rep from \* to last st, k1.

**9th row:** K1, \*k2tog, k1, yfd, k5, yfd, k1, SKPO, rep from \* to last st, k1.

**11th row:** K1, \*(k2tog, yfd, k1) twice, yfd, SKPO, k1, yfd, SKPO, rep from \* to last st, k1.

**13th row:** Work as for 11th row.

**15th row:** Work as for 9th row.

**17th row:** Work as for 7th row.

**18th row:** P.

Rep these 18 rows.

### LACE SCARF:

Using 4mm needles cast on 46sts loosely and work in Lace patt (SEE STS USED) and when work measures 200cm from beg ending with a 18th row of patt, cast off all sts with a bigger needle or loosely.

### TO MAKE UP:

**FRINGES:** Cut lengths of yarn each 30cm long, fold 3 strands tog in half and draw loops through first st at one end of scarf. Draw ends of strands through loop and tighten. Rep this fringes 1cm along each end of scarf. Trim ends.
