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## CABLED SHAWL

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Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

Original garment worked in one size only.

**MATERIALS:** LOVE (50g balls)  
5 balls 3039.  
One 8mm circular knitting needle.

### MEASUREMENTS:

36cm x 160cm without fringes.

*THE INSTRUCTIONS ARE GIVEN FOR THE ONE SIZE ONLY.*

### TENSION: SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME, CHECK TENSION.

15sts and 15 rows = 10cm over cable pattern using an 8mm circular needle.

*FOR BEST RESULTS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT TENSION.*

*IF THERE ARE TOO FEW STS ON TEST SWATCH, USE THINNER NEEDLES;*

*IF THERE ARE TOO MANY STS, USE THICKER NEEDLES.*

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**beg** = begin(ning); **cont** = continue; **C3F** = slip next 2sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, k1, then k2 from cable needle; **C3B** = slip next st onto cable needle and leave at back of work, k2, then k1 from cable needle; **Cr3L** = slip next 2sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, p1, then k2 from cable needle; **Cr3R** = slip next st onto cable needle and leave at back of work, k2, then p1 from cable needle; **C5B** = slip next 3sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, k2, then k3sts from cable needle; **k** = knit; **patt(s)** = pattern(s); **p** = purl; **p2sso** = pass two slipped stitches over; **rep** = repeat; **R(W)SR** = right(wrong) side row; **rev st st** = reversed stocking stitch; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **sl** = slip; **tog** = together; **yfd** = yarn forward.

### STITCHES USED:

CABLE PATTERN (worked over 7sts):

**1st row:** P1, C5B, p1.

**2nd row:** K1, P5, k1.

**3rd row:** C3F, k1, C3B.

**4th row:** P7sts.

**5th row:** K2, yfd, sl2tog, k1, p2sso, yfd, k2.

**6th row:** P7sts.

**7th row:** Work as 5th row.

**8th row:** P7sts.

**9th row:** Work as 5th row.

**10th row:** P7sts.

**11th row:** Work as 5th row.

**12th row:** P7sts.

**13th row:** K7sts.

**14th row:** P7sts.

**15th row:** Cr3L, k1, Cr3R.

**16th row:** K1, p5, k1.

Rep these 16 rows.

REVERSED STOCKING STITCH:

**1st row:** RSF, one row P.

**2nd row:** WSF, one row K. Repeat these 2 rows.

### CABLED SHAWL:

Using an 8mm circular needle, cast on 235sts and cont straight in rev st st and cable patt as folls: **1st row:** P4sts, \*work 1st row of cable patt (SEE STS USED), p4sts, rep from \* to last 4sts, p4sts. **2nd row:** K4sts, \*work 2nd row of cable patt, k4sts, rep from \* to last 4sts, k4sts. Cont straight in patt as now set and when work measures 36cm from beg ending with a 16th row in cable patt. Cast off all sts.

### TO MAKE UP:

Block shawl to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry. **FRINGES:** Cut lengths of yarn, 30cm long. Fold fringe in half and fasten at cast on edge with a crochet hook.
